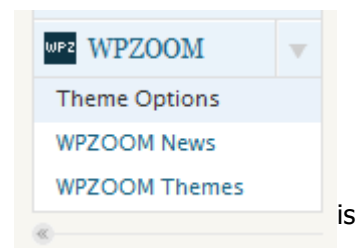

# INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

1. Go to your WordPress Backend.
2. Open Appearance → **Add New Themes**
3. Navigate to **Upload**
4. Browse for **zenko.zip** file on your local computer, and **Install** it.
5. Then go to Appearance → Themes, and **Activate** the theme **Zenko Magazine**

## POST INSTALLATION STEPS

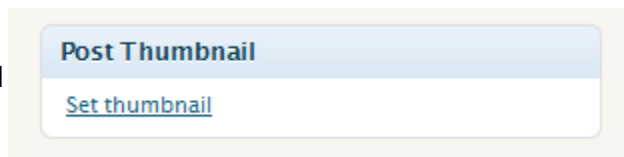
1. A new menu will appear on your Backend – **WPZOOM**. From this menu you will be able to configure **Themes Options**.  
Don't forget to select categories for **Featured Slider** and for **Featured Homepage Categories** if you want to avoid any errors.
2. Navigate to **Appearance** → **Widgets** and add widgets to your theme, as shown in the **Quick Guide.png** image.



## HOW THUMBNAILS SYSTEM WORK?

Since the **WordPress 2.9** has been released we implementing in this theme the great feature called "**Post Thumbnails**", which allows you to upload any image and use it as thumbnail.


On the left side you will see a box: **Post Thumbnail**. Here you can upload an image, and then click "**Use as thumbnail**"



If no image will be selected as Post Thumb, then the theme will pull the **first image** from articles content to be used as thumbnails,.

# HOW TO MANAGE SUMMARY CONTENT

Under the box where you insert your article's content, is placed another box called: **Excerpt**. Here you can insert any content, you want to appear on Homepage in places like: Featured Slider, Featured Boxes, Recent Articles.

# HOW TO CREATE FULL-WIDTH PAGES

When you are trying to create a new page, you'll see a box called "**Template**", and select from that list "**Full Width**" Template.

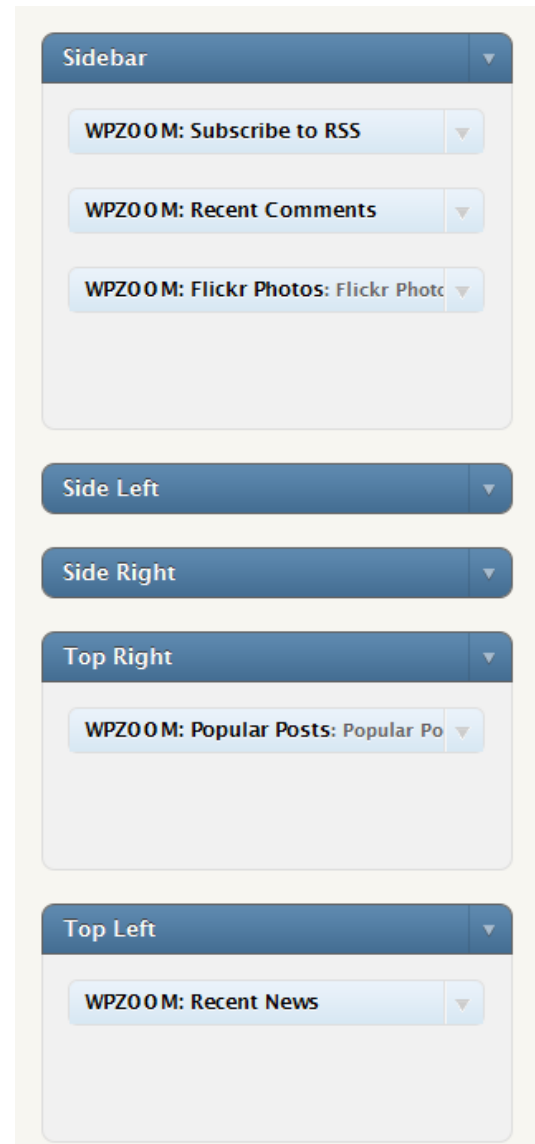

# BUILT-IN WIDGETS

Zenko Magazine Theme has built-in 5 widgets:

- **WPZOOM** Popular News
- **WPZOOM** Recent News
- **WPZOOM** Recent Comments
- **WPZOOM** Subscribe to RSS
- **WPZOOM** Flickr Photos

So, there is no need to have any related plugins, because you can easily place these widgets where you want on your website, but I recommend using the following structure as in following image:



## Some important things to note regarding automatic image resizing

The theme uses the TimThumb PHP script to automatically create and resize the thumbnail images, and in order for it to work properly you need to take note of the following:

- TimThumb requires the [GD library](#), which is available on any host sever with PHP 4.3+ installed.
- The theme has a cache folder for the thumbnail images located at **\zenko\scripts\cache** which requires proper write permissions. If your host server doesn't allow this by default, be sure to manually change the /cache/ folder permissions to **777** (or 755).

In addition, make sure the \scripts\ folder (zenko\scripts\) is set to **777** (or 755).
